

Program Descriptions

Safety Kids

Grades: K, 1st, 2nd **Program Length:** 30 minutes

Descriptions: Each year thousands of kids get bit by dogs, and almost all of these bites could be prevented by teaching kids to be safe around dogs. This program does just that by teaching students how to be safe around unfamiliar dogs. They will learn how dogs communicate through body language, and how to meet dogs they don't know.

Tag is a Ticket Home

Grades: 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th **Program Length:** 30 minutes

Description: Students discuss what animal shelters are, and how animals end up at shelters. Students will learn the importance of tags and microchips for their pets, so they don't end up in a shelter. Students will get the chance to scan Max, our lost stuffed dog looking for his home to learn how microchips in animals work.

Out of Control Kittens

Grades: 3rd, 4th, 5th **Program Length:** 30 Minutes

Description: Students discuss what animal shelters are, and how not spaying & neutering your pets can lead to more homeless animals in the shelter. Students will do an activity to see how fast one un-spayed cat can lead to LOTS of unwanted kittens.

Kind Kids

Grades: 3rd, 4th, 5th **Program Length:** 1 hour

Description: Students can become animal experts by combining both our "Tags are Tickets Home" and "Out of Control Kittens" programs. Kids will earn "Kind Kid" stickers at the end for becoming experts on how to be responsible pet owners.
