Job Title:

Volunteer Photographer

Goal of Position:

Major Responsibilities:

Photograph all animals in shelter. Handle animals in an appropriate and responsible manner. Crop and edit photographs as desired. Deliver photographs to Community Outreach Coordinator either via email or electronic storage device.

Desired Qualifications:

Photography and computer experience are desired, but not requirements for the position.!

Time Commitment:

Photographers will be asked to come in twice a week. The exact hours are flexible, and time spent at the shelter is dependent upon amount of animals needing to be photographed.
